1.1 Operating Hours

Monday through Friday:	5:30 A.M. – 9:00 P.M.
Saturday:	6:00 A.M. - 9:00 P.M.
Sunday:	10:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M.

1.2 Holiday Closures

The District facility will be closed for the following days:

New Year's Day	January 1
Easter	In Accordance
Independence Day	July 4
Thanksgiving	Fourth Thursday in November
Christmas Eve	2 P.M. December 24
Christmas Day	December 25
New Year's Eve	2 P.M. December 31

Full time employees have included in their benefits the closures listed above, excluding. If a closure falls on a weekend, the closest normal workday shall be declared a closure for full-time employees. Hourly employees who work holidays will be paid straight time.

1.3 Other Closures

The Executive Director or the Aquatics Manager has authority to temporarily close the facility if he/she determines it is in the best interest of the District for health or safety concerns.

There will be an annual closure for maintenance each year. The duration will be determined by the William Shore Memorial Pool District Board (Board) and will depend on the amount of maintenance required. Pass holders should be aware of annual maintenance closure and understand William Shore Memorial Pool District (WSMPD) facility will not be available for use at that time.

Inclement Weather: The Executive Director and the Aquatics Manager has the authority to close or change operating hours for the facility due to inclement weather. Please listen to KONP (1450) Radio Station - 457-1450, KSQM 91.5 or check our website's Inclement Weather page at: www.sacpa.org.

Closure due to local or national emergency: It is policy of WSMPD to maintain hours of operation, which make the best use of people and resources in serving the needs of the public. Closure of SAC shall be at the discretion of the Executive Director after consideration of all facts presented. The welfare of the public and WSMPD employees is the main concern.

If an annual, or six month pass includes the WSMPD annual maintenance closure for 3 weeks or greater, the time will be added back on to the pass once the facility re-opens.
